As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, GCC also operates the Powell Museum & Archives in Page, AZ—a cultural and historical hub featuring exhibits on Colorado River exploration, paleontology, geology, Native American history and the unique story of Page and Lake Powell.

Our Impact

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

How to Partner

As a Giving Alliance Partner, you can participate in one or more of the following ways:

TAKE GUEST DONATIONS

- Opt-In: Guests are asked if they would like to make a donation during checkout.
- Opt-Out: A donation is included on the bill but can be removed at the guest's request.
- Round-Up: Guests are asked if they want to round up their purchase total to the nearest dollar, with the extra amount donated to the Conservancy.

PARTICIPATE IN CAUSE MARKETING

- Product Tie-Ins: A portion of sales from specific products or services is donated to GCC.
- Experience-Based Partnerships: Tours or outdoor activities that include a portion of proceeds benefiting GCC.

CONTRIBUTE DIRECTLY

- Percentage Donations: Businesses agree to donate a percentage of their revenue during peak tourism months or from specific products/services.
- Event Sponsorships: The business sponsors GCC events, gaining visibility and associating their brand with conservation.
